Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of maritime colleges/institutions in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total number of students who pass out of these colleges/institutions annually;
- (c) whether the Government has any data regarding the number of students who got placement after passing out from these colleges/institutions during the last three years and the current year and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government provides any kind of financial assistance for students pursuing courses at these centres and other on-board training courses; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the number of students benefitted as a result thereof during the said period?

- (a): The Director General of Shipping, Government of India has recognized 123 maritime training institutes. The State-wise details of Maritime Colleges in the country is as under:-

- (b): The number of students who passed out of these institutes during the last three years is as under:-

- (c) No data is available in respect of placement other than Indian Maritime University (IMU) Campuses. The number of students who got placements in IMU campuses during the last three years i.e. 2014, 2015 and 2016 is 358, 309 and 388 students respectively. For the current year no data is available as the current Academic Year is still going on and Programmes will be completed only in June 2017.
- (d)&(e):No financial assistance is provided to students pursuing courses and for completion of on-board training. However, the number of OBC/SC/ST students who received various scholarships from the Government of India/State Governments for pursuing the courses in IMU Campuses during the years 2015-16 and 2016-17 is 82 and 145 students respectively.
