- (a) whether the Government proposes to conduct feasibility studies for new road projects;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise particularly in Jharkhand;
- (c) the measures taken by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) to mobilize funds for speedy completion of pending and incomplete projects; and
- (d) the total expenditure incurred during the last three years to execute National Highway projects under Public-Private Partnership across the country?

- (a) to (b) The State-wise details of DPR (Detailed projects report) of newly in-principle approved stretches including Jharkhand are given at Annexure.
- (c) Mobilization of funds is a project specific activity which depends on the mode of implementation of projects as in PPP (Public- Private Partnership) projects, fund mobilization is the responsibility of the concessionaire and, in public funded projects, payments are made as per achievement of project milestones.
- (d) Total private sector investment of about Rs 71,517 Crore have been made to execute the National Highways under Public- Private Partnership during the last three years across the country.
