OPERATIONS FROM CALICUT AIRPORT

(a) whether the Government has considered the request to resume the operations of wide body aircraft from the Calicut international airport;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the safety assessment has been done after the renovation works of the runway; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) and (b) : A joint inspection was carried out by Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) and Airports Authority of India (AAI) on 9-10 January, 2017 to assess the possibility of wide-bodied aircraft operations at Calicut Airport wherein it was found that the runway is not suitable for wide-bodied aircraft operations.

(c) and (d) : Runway recarpeting work has been completed on 28.02.2017. Safety Assessment documents are being prepared for submission to DGCA.
