Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (b) if so, whether the Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Kerala for the renovation and development of various Fine Arts colleges in the State;

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MAHENDRA NATH PANDEY)

(a): As informed by University Grants Commission (UGC), Fine Arts Colleges listed under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 and receive grant-in-aid from the State Government are eligible to receive financial assistance from UGC.
