- (b) whether the Government has received proposals from various State Governments including Chhattisgarh for setting up of Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) and General Nursing Midwifery (GNM) training centres and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the present position of the said proposals and the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (d) whether the Government issues license for setting up for private ANM and GNM training centres; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?
