**4873. DR. K. KAMARAJ:**

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of transactions done through Unified Payment Interface from 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2016 to till date;
- (b) whether the Government is aware of reported incidences of loss of money by using new Unified Payment Interface BHIM App.; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken to enhance the security features of the aforesaid App.?

- (a) The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has apprised that the number of approved financial transactions done through Unified Payment Interface (UPI) from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2016 to 26<sup>th</sup> March 2017, is 1,58,23,116.
- (b) and (c) NPCI has apprised that no such incidences of loss of money by using new Unified Payment Interface BHIM App have been reported.
