(a) There are more than 145 Institutions/Academies/Colleges etc. under the Ministry of Defence catering to the requirements of the Armed Forces. In addition to the above, there are many Centres/Laboratories/Institutes engaged in research and training in specialised fields. The Ministry is also funding Institute for Defence Studies and Analyses (IDSA), 4 Mountaineering Institutes, 25 Sainik Schools and 5 Rashtriya Military Schools (RMS).

(b) Approximately 202 acres of land has been acquired where construction of boundary wall, perimeter road, guard rooms and watch tower is nearing completion. Short courses / capsules are expected to commence from the temporary location of the University by July, 2018.

(c) From time to time, such proposals are examined depending on the requirements of the Armed Forces in particular and Defence Sector in general.
