From the above figures, it may be seen that the number of complaints for the year 2016 is slightly less as compared to the previous year.

All the complaints are taken due cognizance of as per the mandated policies and guidelines.

(c) The complaints are inquired into as per laid down provisions and guidelines on the subject and if any delinquency is established, appropriate action is initiated under the Army Act. Cases, where independent investigation is required are referred to the CBI.
