Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to promote Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy in the country;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to implement the Seventh Pay Commission report to Occupational Therapists and Physiotherapists;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to establish a National Council for Occupational Therapy; and
- (e) if so, the details and salient features thereof along with the time by which the said Council is likely to be set up?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): A handbook of Model Curriculum for Physiotherapy has been prepared and uploaded on the website of the Ministry. It has also been sent to all States/UTs for adoption.
- (b) & (c): 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations have been implemented for employees of Central Government offices in so far as pay scales are concerned.
- (d) & (e): No separate Central Council for Occupational Therapy is under consideration yet.
