(a) to (d): Government is fully seized of the security needs of the country and reviews the same from time to time. Required measures including development of infrastructure like roads, rail and airfields are taken to safeguard the sovereignty, territorial integrity and security of India.

A five year (2015-2020) Long Term Roll on Works Plan for new construction / upgradation of 519 roads has been approved for execution by BRO in the border regions of the country. Out of the identified 28 strategic railway lines, Government has approved Final Location Survey of four prioritized railway lines.
