(d) the number of physicians on an average population strength as per the population of India?

(a) & (b): According to Economic survey 2013-14, number of Sub Centers (SC) / Primary Health Centers (PHC), Community Health Centres (CHC), Government Hospitals and AYUSH Hospitals and dispensaries are given below:

(c): As per the information provided by Medical Council of India(MCI), there are a total of 10,12,428 allopathic doctors registered with the State Medical councils/MCI as on 31.12.2016. Assuming 80% availability, it is estimated that around 8.10 lakh doctors may be actually available for active service. The data on numbers of doctors registered with State Medical Councils /MCI is given in annexure I. Further state-wise number of nurses, as available in National Health Profile 2016 are given in annexure-II.

(d): As per the World Health Organisation, number of physician per 1000 population in India was 0.73 in 2014.
