Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to give free gas and water supply connections in all the houses built across the country under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the time by which the said schemes are likely to be implemented;
- (d) the total number of people who will be benefited from these schemes; and
- (e) the total budget for the implementation of the project?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) {PMAY (U)} mission has been launched on 25.06.2015 to facilitate the efforts of the States/UTs to address the housing shortage of its citizens. The Mission will provide central assistance to implementing agencies through States and UTs for providing houses to all beneficiary families/beneficiaries by 2022. The mission guidelines also envisage that houses constructed by the States/UTs should have basic civic infrastructure like water, sanitation, sewerage, road, electricity, etc.

(d) & (e): States/UTs are to undertake a demand assessment and validate the same to determine the actual requirement of houses to be covered under the PMAY (U) mission. For 2017-18, an amount of Rs.4550.90 crore has been provided for PMAY (U) in the Budget Estimate.
