Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of railway land lying vacant in the vicinity of Panipat and Karnal Railway Stations of Haryana;
- (b) whether the Government has chalked out any plan to utilise such waste lands to avoid encroachment; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): Approximately 40 acres of railway land along tracks in Panipat city and two land pockets measuring 3.95 acres land at Karnal are lying vacant. The vacant land at Panipat railway station is required for the future developmental work of Railways and the vacant land at Karnal railway station is meant for Railways staff quarters & Route Relay Interlocking (RRI) building.
