CCTV CAMERAS

5115. SHRI NALIN KUMAR KATEEL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that the Government has installed CCTV cameras on passenger coaches and suburban trains on a pilot basis and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has taken any steps to seek feedback from the train commuters about the implementation of the new initiative in the system; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a): Yes, Madam. The Government has installed CCTV cameras on a limited number of coaches of passenger and suburban trains on a pilot basis. The work has already been completed in about 25 passenger coaches and 90 suburban coaches. In addition to this, 8 Humsafar rakes (176 passenger coaches) that have been turned out by Production Units of Indian Railways, have also been fitted with CCTVs.
- (b) & (c): No, Madam. Feedback from train commuters has not been sought since it is a provision for improving the passenger security.
