Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to modify its recruitment procedures to introduce lateral entries in the Indian Foreign Service (IFS);
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons for the introduction of such a policy and the eligibility criteria envisaged by the Government for including such recruits who have not passed any examination conducted by the UPSC; and
- (c) if not, the measures being taken by the Government to fill up the posts that are lying vacant in the Indian Foreign Service?

- (a) & (b) There is no plan to modify the recruitment procedures of the Indian Foreign Service (IFS).
- (c) Vacancies arising in Indian Foreign Service are filled by direct recruitment through Civil Services Examination and promotions from feeder cadres. Ministry of External Affairs also takes officers from other Departments/ Ministries on deputation.
