NEW BODY FOR INTERNATIONAL PACTS

5145. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of **LAW AND JUSTICE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Parliamentary Panel has recommended for a new body to formulate international pacts and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Parliamentary Panel has also recommended for creation of a new wing-Department of International law-under the Ministry of Law and Justice to ensure that matters related to international treaties and agreements which may inter-alia include multiple treaties on black money and other international agreements are formulated and implemented in a better way; and
- (c) if so, the Government's reaction thereto?

- (a) & (b) Yes Madam. The Department-Related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Personnel, Public Grievances, Law & Justice in its 81st Report, *inter-alia*, has recommended for setting up a new Department of International Law similar to the existing Department of Legal Affairs, Legislative Department and Department of Justice to formulate International Pacts.
- (c) The recommendations requires in depth examination and necessary consultation with the various stake holders by the Government.
