- (b) whether the Government has developed a framework/guidelines to study the index and if so, the details thereof along with the details of guidelines/variables; and
- (c) whether the State Governments are also participating in the preparation of the index and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): This Ministry, after extensive consultations with States/
Cities/ Citizens and peer review by Sector Experts has
developed a draft framework of Liveability Index suited
to conditions prevailing in Indian Cities to rank cities on

the basis of the Liveability Index. The objective of ranking of cities on Liveability Index is to facilitate a competitive environment amongst cities resulting in systematic improvement in the quality of life of citizens.
