UNDERGROUND CABLES

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to lay underground cables in the entire country for the purpose of communication and information technology;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the State-wise details of the total expenditure incurred in this regard during the current financial year;
- (d) whether the Government has fixed any norms to invite tenders in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS & MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) & (b) BharatNet is being implemented for providing broadband connectivity to all Gram Panchayats (GPs) (approx. 2,50,000) in the country. Phase-I to connect 1,00,000 GPs is being implemented currently. Connectivity to GPs in BharatNet Phase-I is being provided by laying underground Optical Fibre Cable (OFC).On 14.12.2016, the Telecom Commission approved a revised implementation strategy with Optimal mix of media i.e. OFC (underground & aerial), radio & satellite to be used to connect remaining around 1,50,000 GPs in BharatNet Phase-II.
- (c) The state-wise details of the total expenditure incurred in this regard during the current financial year (till February, 2017) are given in **Annexure-I.**
- (d) & (e) Phase-I is being implemented through three CPSUs, namely BSNL,PGCIL and RailTel. Tender processes followed by these CPSUs are as per the respective CPSU tender procedures. Work of laying of Optical Fibre Cable and procurement of equipment is being executed by the three CPSUs and BBNL, which is the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) to implement BharatNet through open tender.
