Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of India extends/provide 'Development Aid' to some of the neighbouring countries annually;
- (b) if so, the details of the development aid extended to neighbouring countries during the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17;
- (c) whether due to cut in development aid to some of the neighbouring countries particularly Nepal, the relations with them have strained; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government to create good relations with Nepal?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (Dr) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

(a) Yes, Government of India provide 'Development Aid' to neighbouring countries.

(b) The amount of aid India provided to neighbouring countries annually in 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 is enclosed at Annexure.

(c) There is no cut in development aid. However the actual disbursement varies from year to year as per progress/actual need basis of various projects in the relevant year.
