- (b) the number of delegates who have participated in the said summit along with the outcome of the summit;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any study on the development of the North-Eastern Region compared to other parts of the country and if so, the details and outcome of the study; and
- (d) the details of the various Central Subsidies sanctioned and released to each North-Eastern State for promoting the industries during each of the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

The Minister of State (Independent Charge) of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region [Dr. Jitendra Singh]

- (a) The Eleventh North Eastern Business Summit was organised by the Indian Chamber of Commerce (ICC) in New Delhi on 9th and 10th March, 2017 in which Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region had also participated in various sessions.
- (b) Information on number of delegates and outcome is not available with the Ministry since this was organised by the ICC.
- (c) While this Ministry is aware of studies undertaken on specific sectors required for giving a boost for the infrastructure development in the North Eastern Region, it is not aware of any specific study in which comparisons have been made on the development of the region with other parts of the country.
- (d) The details of the various subsidies sanctioned under the North East Industrial and Investment Promotion Policy (NEIIPP) 2017 upto March, 2017 are at **Annexure**.
