Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether skill development syllabus has been introduced by the Government in the country;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof including Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu during the last three years;
- (c) the number of unemployed persons to whom employment has been provided under the programme, so far; and
- (d) the profession-wise details of the companies where these persons have been employed?

(a) to (d) Ministry through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) is implementing its flagship schemes namely Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) on pan India basis to cover the prospective youths including State of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu. PMKVY enables large number of youths for taking short term Fresh Training and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training partner/training centers. The primary objective of PMKVY is to encourage and promote Skill Development for the youth throughout the country. Under the scheme, there are 221 job roles related to 35 Sector Skill Councils covering entire country including state of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu. These Job Roles includes the sectors namely; Agriculture, Apparels Made Ups & Home Furnishing, Automotive, Beauty & Wellness, Capital Goods, Constructions, Domestic Workers, Food Processing, Furniture & Fittings, Gems & Jewellery, Green Jobs, Handicrafts, Healthcare, Iron & Steel, IT/ITes, Leather, Life Science, Logistics, Media, Mining, Paints & Coatings, Plumbing, Power, Retail, Rubber, Security, Sports, Telecom, Textiles Handlooms, Tourism & Hospitality, etc. which is a diverse and exhaustive representation of the industry. Syllabus/ Curriculums for skill training in the country including Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu encompass 221 Job Roles in

diverse sectors. Under PMKVY, 20,98,839 candidates have been trained throughout the country as on 9th March, 2017. Out of 20,98,839 candidates, 1,11,510 and 1,89,050 candidates have been trained in the state of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu respectively. State wise details of candidates trained under PMKVY is given at **Annexure-I**. Under PMKVY 2015-16, it was not mandatory for NSDC's Training Providers to report employment data. However, as per the reported data, 2.47 lakhs number of candidates have been given the placement offer. Under PMKVY (2016-2020) scheme, the focus on employment has been significantly enhanced. Scheme incentivizes Training Centers (TCs)/ Training Providers (TPs) for facilitating placement of the trained candidates. TCs are mandated to organize placement / Rozgar Melas every six month with the support of Sector Skill Councils (SSCs). Till date multiple Rozgar Melas have been organized with participation from more than 350 employers from various sectors.
