MoUs WITH CHINESE COMPANIES

5302. SHRI R.P. MARUTHARAJAA:

Will the Minister of NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Indian companies are in the process of signing Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with the Chinese companies worth over \$22 billion on proposed investments in renewable energy infrastructure;
- (b) if so, the details of the project proposals in this regard and the places where these projects are proposed to be set;
- (c) whether the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia and France have shown their interest to invest in the new and renewable energy sector in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and response of the Government thereto?
