SHORTAGE OF ATCS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

- (a) whether the Government is concerned about the shortage of Air Traffic Controllers (ATCs) in airports across the country, if so, the details thereof ;
(b) whether the Government has also decided to allow private players to set up training facilities for air traffic control officers to address manpower shortage in air traffic management activities; and
(c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a): Yes, Madam. In order to mitigate the shortage of Air Traffic Control Officers (ATCOs), Airports Authority of India (AAI) has recruited 200 ATCOs in 2015 (of which 179 joined) and 400 ATCOs in 2016 (of which 393 have already joined). Further, AAI has initiated the process for recruitment of 400 more ATCOs in 2017.
