Contribution of Universities to R&D

535. SHRI B.V. NAIK:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any status report on the contribution of Indian Universities and other higher education as well as research bodies in Research and Development activities in the country;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has any ranking based on contributions to Research and Development to such institutions; and
- (c) if so, the details of the breakthroughs recorded, achieved and published related to Research and Development by the top ten among these institutions during the last two years?

(a) to (c): As per the database published by M/s. Elsevier, India has produced 6.46 lakh research publication in the Scopus database between 2010-15 and stood at rank 7th in the Global Research ranking. India has a global share of 4.2% in research publications in 2013. The Government has established National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) where 30% weightage is given for the research publications. The first such rankings have been released in April, 2016.
