a) whether the Government had directed to include the services performed by the employees at village/Panchayat in evaluation of their performance for promotions/rewards;

b) if so, the details and the objectives thereof;

c) whether the Government also proposes to introduce ranking and development index for the panchayat;

d) if so, the details thereof; and

e) whether the Government proposes to involve women self help groups for audit of rural welfare schemes and if so, the details thereof ?

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PANCHAYATI RAJ

### (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) & (b): 'Panchayat' being in the realm of 'Local Bodies' is a State subject. The engagement of employees for Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) including the services performed by them, their performance, promotions/ rewards etc. are the primary responsibilities of State Governments concerned.

(c) : There is no proposal to introduce ranking and development index for the Panchayat.

(d) Does not arise.

(e): The Government has promoted Self Help Groups (SHGs) under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) programme mobilizing rural households across the States and UTs. DAY-NRLM as a programme design, promotes community auditors who are essentially either the SHG members, book keepers and / or children of SHG members, to manage and monitor their performance and bring in transparency in financial management. Further, Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR) has also issued a detailed advisory on "Panchayat- SHG convergence for Participatory Planning at Gram Panchayat level". This advisory, *inter-alia*, has requested the States for inclusion of SHGs/ federations in community based monitoring of schemes and projects of Gram Panchayat.
