(a) & (b): Seventy-seven National Highways (NHs) including NH-1 in a length of 12109 km have been identified under National Highway Development Programme (NHDP) Phase-III for upgradation to 4-Lane in the country. Rs.14976 crores have been released to the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) till February, 2017 for meeting the expenditure requirement for various works identified under NHDP including the projects under NHDP Phase-III during the financial year 2016-17.
