(a) to (b): Airports Authority of India (AAI) has undertaken the work of re-carpeting / strengthening and extension of Runway at Surat Airport in two phases at an estimated cost of Rs. 50.62 crores. The Phase-I work of extension of runway has already been completed. Further, AAI has commenced work for interim modification of existing terminal building of Surat Airport to facilitate international operations at a cost of Rs.18.95 lakh and construction of Cargo Terminal Complex with an outlay of Rs.10.37 crores. AAI will undertake further expansion once land acquisition for the runway and new terminal is completed.
