(a) & (b) This Ministry has not received any proposal from the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh for additional grant under NRDWP for its Water Grid Project. However, the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh has submitted two proposals for funding from external agencies and the same has been examined in this Ministry.
