- (a) to (b) An India Sanitation Conference-2016 (Indosan-2016) was jointly organized on 30th September, 2016 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi by this Ministry and Ministry of Urban Development. Besides taking stock of the progress in urban and rural areas under Swachh Bharat Mission over the last two years and looking at the way forward, commitment to ensure Clean India by 2019 was renewed. The conference was inaugurated by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.
