ESTABLISHMENT OF CANCER DETECTION CLINICS

5618. SHRI M.B. RAJESH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is planning to establish cancer detection clinics in each district in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof including the funds allocated for the same, State/UTwise;

(c) whether a number of States have expressed their interest in establishing such clinics in the country and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government has any plan to offer AYUSH services to cancer patients in the country and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) whether the Government maintains data about the number of cancer cases, State/ UT-wise and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c): The Government of India is implementing the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS) under National Health Mission (NHM) for interventions upto district level. The objectives of the programme includes setting up of NCD clinics, awareness generation, prevention, opportunistic screening and referral to an appropriate level institution. Among Cancer, focus is on 3 common Cancers, viz. Breast, Oral and Cervical. Population level screening of common NCDs such as hypertension, diabetes and common Cancer (viz. Oral, Breast and Cervical) is initiated under NHM. 100 districts have been identified for this. The States submit their Programme Implementation Plans which are considered appropriately. As informed by States, till December, 2016, 367 NCD clinics have been opened in States. Details of funds released to the States during 2016-17 under NCD Flexipool is at **Annexure-I**.

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(d): The Ministry of AYUSH through its three research organizations, namely, Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH) and Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM) has launched a programme to integrate Ayurveda, Homoeopathy and Unani with NPCDCS. The major objective of the programme is prevention and early diagnosis of these diseases; reduce complications; reduce drug dependency through these systems. It also aims at capacity building for human resource development.

(e): National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research (NCDIR), an institute under the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) is implementing Cancer Registry. As per information provided by ICMR, the State/UT wise estimated incidence of cancer cases in the country, for the year 2016 is at **Annexure-II**.
