Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has created relevant indicators to assess and monitor gender equality under the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has fixed any targets for SDG goals of gender equality and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the timeframe by which the indicators will be decided and targets be set?
