- (a) whether the Government has implemented any scholarship scheme for single girl child in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the main features as well as objectives of the scheme;
- (c) whether the Government has proposed/proposes to also include more number of girl children other than single girl child in a family under the said scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (Dr. MAHENDRA NATH PANDEY)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The University Grants Commission (UGC) is implementing two schemes for Single Girl Child in the country viz. (i) Swami Vivekananda Single Girl Child fellowship for Research in Social Sciences (for pursuing M.Phil./Ph.D.) and (ii) Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Fellowship for Single Girl Child (for pursuing Post-Graduation).

The scheme-wise salient features and main objectives of these schemes are as follows:
