(a) & (b) : Yes, Madam. The Ministry of Human Resource Development through University Grants Commission (UGC) is providing grants for development of the infrastructure including specific equipment/facilities etc. to the UGC approved Universities across the country for three Skill development programmes namely, Community Colleges, B.Voc degree programme and DeenDayal Upadhyay Kaushal Kendras.
