- (b) if so, details thereof; and
- (c) the proposal of the Government along with the financial sector to support such women to get admission in business schools in the country?

ANSWER

- (a): No, Madam. There is no such report available with the Government at present. In fact, as per some of the news paper reports, the ratio of female students in premier MBA institutes such as Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) has risen over the past years.
