SCHEMES FOR WOMEN WORKERS IN AP

589. SHRI RAYAPATI SAMBASIVA RAO:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government is running any specific schemes or programmes aimed at improving the status of women workers in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b)if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the total funds allocated by Union Government and the fund spent by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh for the said purpose during the last three years, scheme/programme-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Labour & Employment is administering Grant-in-aid Scheme for welfare of women labourers under which financial assistance in the form of Grant-in-aid is provided directly to Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs)/Voluntary Organisations (VOs) for organising seminars/workshops etc. aimed at raising the general consciousness of women labour. Also special training programmes exclusively for women workers are conducted by Central Board of Workers Education (CBWE) for their empowerment and welfare.

There is no separate State/UT-wise allocation of funds under the scheme.
