Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of works being undertaken by the National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) in the country, State/UT Wise including Chattisgarh;
- (b) the details of funds sanctioned and utilized by the NSIC during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the number of people who became entrepreneurs with the help of NSIC during the said period, State/UT-wise including Chattisgarh?

**ANSWER**

(a): The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd., (NSIC) has been working to fulfill its mission of promoting, aiding and fostering the growth of micro, small & medium enterprises. It provides support for development of micro, small & medium enterprises (MSMEs) through various schemes & services such as raw material distribution, credit support for raw material procurement, tender & consortia marketing and technical assistance to MSMEs. It also implements two schemes of the Ministry namely Performance & Credit Rating (PCR) Scheme and Marketing Assistance Scheme.

NSIC provides a package of services as per the needs of the MSMEs. The Corporation acts as a facilitator for MSMEs and provides them integrated support in the areas of marketing, credit, technology and other support services through its 163 offices in the country. In addition, NSIC has set up Training-cum-Incubation Centres in different parts of the country

NSIC organizes programmes for Skill Development and Self-Employment through its 7 Technical Centres (NTSC) located at Aligarh (Uttar Pradesh), Chennai (Tamil Nadu), Howrah (West Bengal), Hyderabad (Telangana), Okhla (New Delhi), Rajkot (Gujarat) and Rajpura (Punjab) in the domains like Computer Science, Software development, Electrical, Electronics, Mechanical, Mechatronics, Civil etc.

NSIC has also established 6 Technology Incubation Centres (TIC) at Okhla (New Delhi), Howrah (West Bengal), Guwahati (Assam), Kanaid (Himachal Pradesh), Jubbal (Himachal Pradesh), Kolar (Karnataka) for development of skills and entrepreneurship.

NSIC is having a scheme named “NSIC Technology Incubation Centre” (TIC) for setting up incubation centres under PPP Mode. As on 28/02/2017, 110 centres under PPP mode are functioning. NSIC is having 1 TIC under PPP mode located at Mahasamund in Chhattisgarh.

Further, NSIC has also established six Livelihood Business Incubators (LBI) under ASPIRE Scheme of the ministry of MSME at Deoria(UP),Naini(UP), Chennai(Tamilnadu), Kashipur (Uttarakhand), Nawada (Bihar) and Rajkot (Gujarat) for development of required skills and entrepreneurship.

(b): NSIC is implementing three Plan Schemes on behalf of Ministry of MSME. These schemes are (i) Performance & Credit Rating Scheme (PCRS) (ii) Marketing Assistance Scheme (MAS) and (iii) National SC-ST Hub (NSSH) Scheme for which budgetary support is provided to NSIC. There is no state wise allocation of funds under these schemes. Details of funds released to NSIC for implementation of these schemes during the year 2013-14 to 2016-17 are given hereunder:

**Entrepreneurship Development Programme(EDP)**-The objective of the programme is imparting training to students/youth for self employment. In the programme training on live projects, project preparation , marketing etc is given to the student. W.e.f 2016-17, the duration of this programme is standardized to 180 Hrs.

**Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme(ESDP)**-This programme focused on the skills development of students/youth with duration ranging from one month to two years.
