INCREASE IN NDRF BATTALIONS

(a) whether it is a fact that the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) has sought to increase its battalions from its present strength of 12 to 20 battalions and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the NDRF has also sought approval for creation of its own dedicated aviation wing and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the NDRF is increasing its presence along side the military which is still the predominant rescue and relief operation agency in the country; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?
