- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce common course in all the National and State Education Boards in the country and if so, the details thereof
- (b) whether it is a fact that the Government is pushing more and more schools to follow CBSE syllabus or start CBSE schools in the country to have uniform syllabus in all the schools and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the applications for starting CBSE schools in the States including Andhra Pradesh are pending for clearance from the Government and if so, the details thereof during the last three years along with the reasons thereof, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the status of such applications, State/UT-wise and the time by when such applications are likely to be approved?
