**6051. SHRIMATI RANJANBEN BHATT:**

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

**(a) whether there are links of ISI in several States including Delhi and Bihar;**

**(b) if so, whether the Government proposes to take concrete and effective steps to check their activities; and**

**(c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be done?**

**(a) to (c): Few persons having linkages with Pakistan's ISI have come to notice in some States. The Government has been pursuing a well-coordinated and multi-pronged approach to tackle such activities which include gearing up the intelligence machinery to interdict Pakistani agents, close interaction and coordination between different agencies of the Centre and the State Governments, strengthening of vigilance on the borders to check infiltration and illegal cross border activities, sensitization of staff and officers, installations of CCTVs, biometric and electronic surveillance and cyber security.**
