- (d) if so, the actual amount of estimated savings?

(a) to (d): In accordance with the recommendations of the Expenditure Management Commission (EMC), sugar subsidy scheme has been discontinued in its present form w.e.f. FY 2017-18. However, continuation of the scheme with restrictive coverage has been taken up with the competent authority and hence, estimated savings cannot be calculated.
