(d) if not, the reasons therefor?;

(c) to (d): As per an order issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the certificates / qualifications of the Madrasa Board which have been granted equivalence by the corresponding State Board of Education to that of their Secondary and Senior Secondary qualifications can be considered equivalent by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE) and / or by any other School Examination Board, for the purpose of employment.
