**Skill Development Centres in Universities**

620. SHRI RAJESH KUMAR DIWAKER:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the University Grants Commission (UGC) has taken any decision to open skill development centres in universities and other higher educational institutions in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh and the time by which these centres are likely to be set up?

(a) & (b): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that, under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF), it is implementing three skill development schemes viz. (a) Community Colleges; (b) B.Voc Degree Programme and (c) Deen Dayal Upadhyay KAUSHAL Kendra with a view to skilling the youth and creating industry-fit manpower. State-wise skill development centres supported by UGC including in the state of Uttar Pradesh under these three schemes are at Annexure.
