- (a) whether the Government is ready to include plantation workers who do not have their own house and land under various housing schemes in various States like Kerala;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is ready to provide assistance to exclusive flagship programmes like "Own your housing scheme" implemented by Government of Kerala for this purpose and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has received any representation from the Government of Kerala in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the action taken thereon so far?
