#### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Mumbai Central Station along with some other important railway stations in Maharashtra are in the identified list of stations for redevelopment work; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Indian Railways has made known to public its plan to offer 'A-1' and 'A' category stations for redevelopment on 'as is where is' basis by inviting proposals from interested parties with their designs and business ideas. The entire cost of station redevelopment is to be met by leveraging commercial development of land and air space in and around the station.

There are 40 'A-1' and 'A' category stations in the State of Maharashtra out of which, bids for redevelopment of 6 stations viz. Bandra Terminus, Borivali, Lokmanya Tilak (Terminus), Mumbai Central, Pune and Thane, have been invited in the first phase.
