Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be p

leased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to make the weekly train service 16734 and 16733 running between Okha-Rameshwaram-Okha *via* Manmad, Nanded, Sikandarabad and Tirupati a daily service;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor along with the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) and (b): No, Madam. There is no proposal at present for increasing the frequency of this train service.

(c): This train has primary maintenance at Rameswaram and secondary maintenance at Okha. The existing infrastructure facilities at both Rameswaram and Okha are not adequate to run this train as a daily service.
