- (c) whether complaints regarding negligence in security arrangements and extortion by Railway Protection Force personnel has been rising incessantly and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of steps taken to strengthen the security arrangements of railway passengers in last three years?

(a) & (b): The details of incidents of various crimes reported in Railways and the details of Railway employees as well as others found involved in such crimes during the years 2014, 2015 and 2016 are appended.

(c): No, Madam.

(d): Policing on Railways being a State subject, prevention of crime, registration of cases, their investigation and maintenance of law & order in Railway premises as well as on running trains are the statutory responsibility of the State Governments, which they discharge through Government Railway Police (GRP)/District Police. Railway Protection Force (RPF) supplements the efforts of GRP to provide better protection and security of passenger area & passengers and for matters connected therewith. Measures initiated by the Railways to strengthen security over Railways, in coordination with Government Railway Police of respective States include escorting of trains, access control, operationalisation of Security Helpline (182) and Twitter Handle, surveillance over about 344 stations through close circuit television cameras, etc. Regular coordination is made with the State Police/GRP authorities at all levels for prevention of crime, registration of cases, their investigation and maintenance of law & order in Railway premises as well as on running trains.
