MULTI-SKILLING COURSES BY CoE

6309. SHRI MANSUKHBHAI DHANJIBHAI VASAVA:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Centre of Excellence (CoE) has introduced multi-skilling courses of two years duration in various ITIs of India;
- (b) if so, the number of courses that has been started so far;
- (c) whether the funds released for the above said proposal has not been utilized fully during the last three years;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether the Government has tried to ascertain that any pressure/activities from the private technical institutions has resulted in the non-utilisation of funds fully in order to make this proposal a total failure; and
- (f) if so, the reaction of the Government thereon?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) to (b) The Center of Excellence (CoE) course is a modular multi-skilling course comprising of introduction of Broad Based Basic Training (BBBT) course of one year duration followed by 6 month course onAdvanced module in the Industrial Training Institute (ITI) and a Specialised module of 6 months as shop floor training in industry.21 Industrial sectors have been identified and curricula of more than 200 modules are developed:
- (c) to (d) The existing Government ITIs are upgraded under various centrally sponsored schemes which mostly cover upgradation and/or introduction of courses under conventional pattern of Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) and introduction of courses under CoE scheme in few ITIs. Most of the ITIs have completed the infrastructure. The scheme-wise status on fund utilization is attached as **Annexure-I**.
- (e) to (f) No such case has come to the notice of Ministry.
