6323. SHRI JAYADEV GALLA:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has given funds to open 170 ITIs in various States;

(b) if so, the details of status of the above initiative, State-wise; and

(c) the status of progammes/schemes proposed in 11th and 12th Plan periods, year-wise, Statewise and programme/ scheme-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

- (a) Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) is an area development programme being implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs w.e.f. 2008-09 aimed at improving the socio-economic condition and providing basic amenities for improving the quality of life of minorities by creating infrastructures for Education, Health and Skill development. The Ministry under MsDP has approved construction of 168 ITIs in identified Minority Concentrated areas of various States under MsDP.
- (b) The State-wise list along with the status of approved ITIs is at Annexure.
- (c) Beside ITIs, proposals related to other infrastructural projects received from the State Governments as per their requirement have also been approved under MsDP. These interalia, include School Building, Sadvabhna Mandaps, Degree College, Hostels, ITIs, Polytechnics, Drinking Water & Sanitation, Pucca Housing under IAY and Residential Schools.
