†6375. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to start broadband services in all Government schools;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide computer education in Government schools and link them with broadband internet services with a view to making the digital India programme, a success; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS & MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (d) Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD) has approved 89,583 ICT enabled schools (Govt. and Govt. aided) in the country till date since inception of the ICT in Schools scheme under RMSA (Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan). Under ICT@Schools scheme (Scheme of Information and Communication Technology in Schools), financial support for 10 Personal Computers (or one Server with 10 Terminals), 1 Projector, 1 Printer, 1 Scanner, 1 Web Camera, 1 modem, Broadband antenna, Generator/ Solar Package, Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS), video camera, Internet / Broadband charges etc. are provided. The scheme has been implemented in 62,820 schools and in 26,763 ICT schools the scheme is yet to be implemented by the States/UTs (State-wise list attached at Annexure). It may also be mentioned that till 2016-17, 88,078 were approved and 1,505 (tentative) more schools have approved in 2017-18.
