Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has prepared a report on pre and post projects for water supply, sewerage networks and septage management, storm water drains, urban transport and provision of green spaces and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the Government has monitored the additional investment of Rs. 19,170 crore and its implementation in improving basic urban facilities and if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT

## (RAO INDERJIT SINGH)

(a)&(b): The Government has launched the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) to assist the States in development of Urban infrastructure including, water supply, sewerage networks, septage management, water drainage, urban transportation and provision of green spaces in 500 cities to be implemented over a period of 5 years with an outlay of Rs. 50000 crore. Under the Mission the Ministry of Urban Development approves the State Annual Action Plans(SAAPs) of States/Union Territories(UTs) and releases the Central Assistance(CA). Preparation of Detailed Project Reports(DPRs) of projects, their appraisal, tendering and execution is done by the States/UTs. The SAAPs of all States/UTs with an investment of Rs 61579 crore have already been approved. An amount of Rs 4347 crore has been released to the States as first instalment of CA. The Mission is expected to provide universal coverage of water supply and improve other urban infrastructure in the 500 Mission cities.
